Grace Student Ministry Summer Intern Program Information:

Purpose of the Internship:

Grace Student Ministries exists to support and love students in meaningful relationships that lead to lives transformed by Jesus through Grace's Worship, Equip, Serve, Together model. There are three main purposes for the Grace Summer Internship. First, the purpose is for students to grow in their relationship with Jesus through their relationship with the intern. Second, the purpose is to help the intern discern and develop any call he/she may have for ministry. And, third, the purpose is to educate the intern in how to be a follower of Christ both in and outside of a church position.

Expectations:

- 1. Intentionally walk with Jesus in personal life
- 2. Intentionally invest time in developing relationships with students and the church as a whole
- 3. Discover and develop spiritual gifts
- 4. Willing to be vulnerable and authentic with students, staff, and volunteers
- 5. Eager to serve without grumbling despite changing circumstances

Requirements:

- 1. You must be one year post-high school graduation.
- 2. You will be required to be present and serving on/at: Sundays, Summer Bible Studies (2x a week 6-8pm), Mission Trips (June 25-July 1 and July 8-14), and VBS (June 11-15).
- 3. Your work week requirements will be discussed with you if you are offered a position in light of your role as a student. Typically, Daniel and Liz work Monday-Thursday from 9-5pm and most of the day Sunday.
- 4. You will be required to serve, at minimum, at one Backyard and one Treehouse time along with Tuesday Childcare. So, every Tuesday and at least two Sunday mornings you will work with the Children's Ministry team alongside many of our students who volunteer at these events. You might also be involved with our College/YA ministry.
- 5. You will be required to teach at least one Sunday Morning.
- 6. You will be required to read a book on ministry with Liz and Daniel. The weekly reading requirements will be discussed if you are offered a position.

Dates & Compensation:

I: BASIC INFORMATION:

Interns will be paid \$300 a week for up to 10 weeks. The maximum compensation for the Grace Student Ministry Internship is \$3,000. The specific weeks can be discussed if you are offered the position, but you must work the weeks of VBS and mission trips.
